Study tours to Berlin and Kiev for journalists and civil society activists
from Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine and Russia

Within the project “Valuing Diversity and Pluralism (VALDIP)” the Berlin-based Institute for Analysis and Policy Dialogue -IFaP e.V., the Institute on Migration Policy - RUSMPI and the Ukrainian NGO Human Rights Platform invite bloggers, journalists and civil society activists to two study trips to Kiev/Kramatorsk and Berlin. During the study tours, participants will meet refugees, be trained by international experts and discuss the impact of migrants and refugees on societies in Eastern Europe, Russia and Germany.

WHEN & WHERE

- Kiev + Kramatorsk, Ukraine from 28 October to 1 November 2018
- Berlin, Germany from 17 to 20 December 2018.

- blogger, journalist or civil society activist
- resident of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine and Russia
- motivated to actively participate and contribute to the project
- ready to reflect your values and positions
- experienced in working on the topics of pluralism, diversity, human rights, migration
- want to develop your journalistic competencies through trainings
- have at least intermediate knowledge of English (B1)

CONDITIONS

- participation in both workshops is compulsory
- write and publish one article on a migration/refugee topic
- prepare a short analysis on media coverage during the workshops

Organisers cover travel & accommodation costs. Participants need to buy round way tickets on their own and in advance and will be reimbursed at the end of each workshop **on presentation of proof of payment**. Reimbursement of travel expenses is limited to 270€ per workshop/participant.
